Ridley Township Public Library's 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten program is a fun, exciting, and free way to start your child on the path to success!

### How does the program work?

#### Register

Any child ages birth to five years can participate. Sign up in the library and receive your first reading log and a free book.

#### **Track Your Reading**

Read to your child and color in a circle on your reading log for every book read.

#### **25-Book Milestones**

For every 25 books read, stop by the library to receive a sticker. You don't even have to show us your reading log. This is a small incentive to encourage you and your child to keep reading and logging those books, and to let you know we're rooting for you!

#### 100-Book Milestones

Each time you read 100 books, bring your reading log to the library to receive a sticker, coloring page, and a free book!

#### 1,000 Books

You did it! Come celebrate at the library!



## 1,000 books...absolutely!

5 books a week for 4 years = 1,040 books 1 book a night for 3 years= 1,095 books 10 books a week for 2 years= 1,040 books

- Count books read in story time or preschool

- If your child wants to hear the same book over and over, you can count it each time. There's nothing wrong with rereading a book- in fact, it's encouraged!

# 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten Backpacks


Not sure what to read next? Looking for something new to try? Checkout a 1,000 Books backpack!
